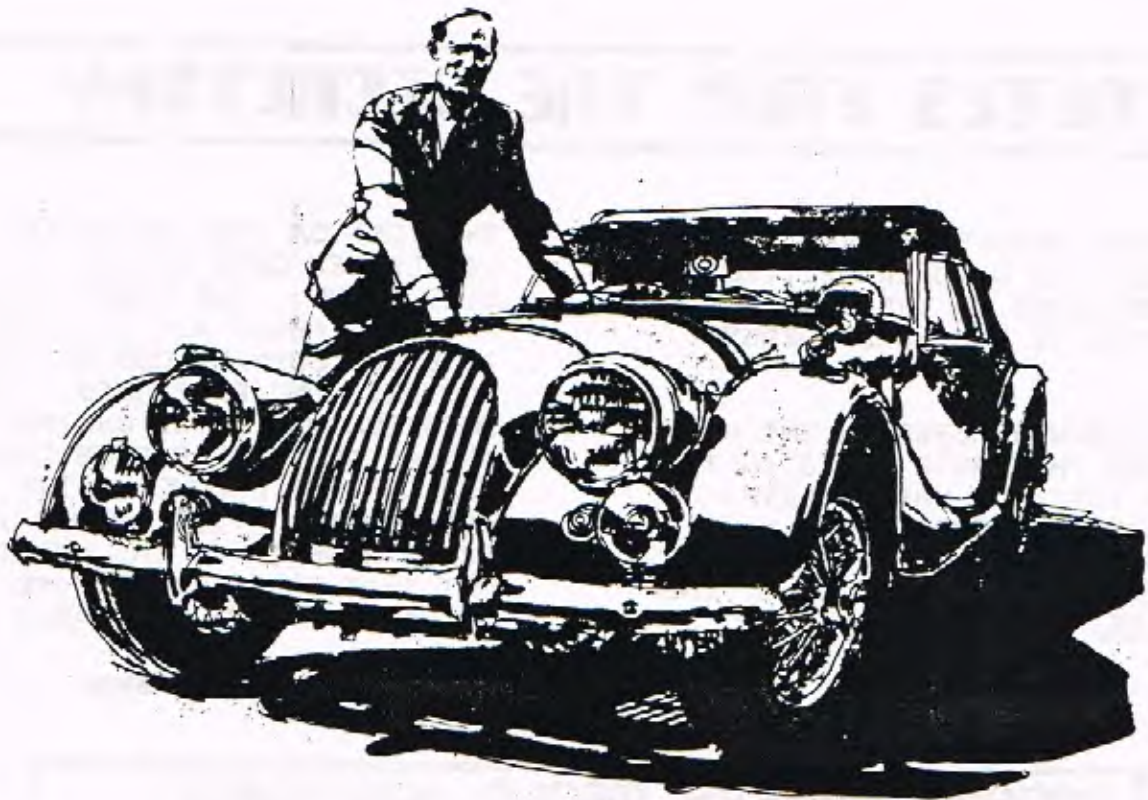

# FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Morgan Owners,

As we approach the end of the most successful year the Morgan Owners Group has had, I feel inclined to write what might be termed a "State of the Union" letter.

Although we have been blessed with the doubling of our membership over the last several years, the most outstanding increase has come in terms of actual participation in the club events and tours. To my personal amazement, when the planning meeting is held at the beginning of the year, we now have members "almost waiting in line" to put on events. The quality of these activities reflects this enthusiasm. Through a High Quality informative newsletter and the hard work of some of our Seattle area members we have truly become a Northwest Club. In this fact lies the dilemma and the challenge for the upcoming year.

As outlined by Bob Hauge in the last issue of the Mogazine, it is the feeling of the current officers that perhaps changing to a quarterly business meeting in a more central location (et. Olympia) would both broaden the base of participation and at the same time, lessen the hourly commitment of the officers. The newsletter would become the responsibility of a yearly editor, with "mandantory" contributions from officers and event reports. This would allow any member "regardless of location" to be editor and yet not feel responsible for single handidly writing the monthly newsletter.

Being involved with an automobile whose biggest change in 50 years is doing away with chrome headlights, these proposals may seem sweeping. Not wanting to make changes without a clear direction we have postponed elections until March. Elsewhere in this issue Bob has composed a questionnaire.
