Several years ago a Canadian buddy of mine had installed a Steering Damper on his 4/4. He just got tired of the "Miserable Morgan Wheel Wobble" and decided to take the easy way out. His Damper was called "Yellow Jacket" or something like that and he had it installed by a RV Shop or Off Road shop.

I thought this was a good idea so I went to a local VW Repair Shop and bought a VW Steering damper for about \$22 and jury rigged an installation. It worked but not a very clean installation.

While at "Devil's Punch Bowl" I noticed Roger Huntley had a similar Steering Damper but he had a very clean installation. He explained that he had purchased this from a California Hot Rod shop. With very little modification it clamps right into a Morgan.
